





What is Phonics?

- Children have a daily 20 min phonics lessons
- Children are taught to read by breaking words down into separate sounds or 'phonemes'. They are then taught how to blend these sounds together to read the whole word
- Children are also taught to write words by sounding and segmenting words into phonemes. They then write the sounds they can hear and check by reading the word
- There are around 40 different sounds.


Digraphs are introduced (2 letters making one sound).




Trigraphs are introduced (3 letters making one sound).



Blends are covered (2 or 3 letters working together at the beginning/end of words).



Alternative sounds and split digraphs are introduced.




Sound Buttons

- These are used to represent the individual sounds/phonemes in words.
- They are used when the children read words and also to check words that they write.
- They will be able to use these during the phonics check.
