This week we will be thinking about Easter and Springtime.					
<p>AM</p>	<p>Have a picnic with 4 of your toys-can you give everyone a plate? A cup? Can you pour them a drink with a little help from your grown up? Can you share your snacks with your toys?</p> <p>Can you draw a picture of your special picnic?</p> 	<p>With your grown up look outside every window in your house. What can you see outside of each window? Use your words to say and complete the sentence with an adult 'I can see...'</p> <p>Can you spot any signs of Spring from your window? What is your favourite view out of your windows at home and why?</p>	<p>Write the letters in your name! Grown up's please can you write your child's name on a piece of paper (Capital letter at the start and lower case letters). Encourage your child to write the letters of their name or just the first letter. This can be done in a variety of ways- on paper, chalk outside, in sand or sprinkle a little flour or salt on a plate/baking tray. Encourage your child to form each letter independently talking them through the movement. E.g. S around, around</p>	<p>Decorate an Easter egg. Grown up's draw a large egg shape on a piece of paper or outside on the ground with chalk. Encourage children to decorate their egg how they wish. With felt tips, pencils, loose parts such as pasta, bottle lids, leaves, stickers. Any way you wish!</p> 	<p>Go on a number hunt around your home. Adults-write numbers on post-it notes or pieces of paper and put up around your home. Focus on numbers 1-10 and move onto to numbers 10-20 for a challenge when you repeat the activity, or add bigger numbers for older siblings. Go around your house looking for numbers and shout out what numbers you find. If you're not sure what the number is, look at it with your grown up.</p>
<p>PM</p>	<p>Go for a Spring walk. Can you spot the signs of Spring with your grown up? Buds on the trees, flowers growing. Talk about what you can see on your walk. Can you feel the warmer weather on your skin? Can you feel the wind blowing your hair? What does the grass feel like?</p> 	<p>Paint a rainbow picture to put up at your window if you haven't already. Talk about the colours and sing the rainbow song. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=y7nE4ADGaOc What is your favourite colour on the rainbow? See how many different ways you can move your body.</p>	 <p>Choose a story and settle down in a quiet place to read it with your grown up. Can you talk about your favourite part of the story?
