Around your poster draw and label objects that are that colour. Challenge: Can you write a sentence using the word 'because'? I like red because	Rainbow flower experiment Using white flowers (carnations work well) or lettuce leaves. Cut the ends diagonally, with the help of an adult. Then place them into glasses half filled with water and some food colouring. Observe them for 4/6 hours. What happens? Flower facts Research your favourite flower from the story using books you may have or the internet. Talk with someone that lives with you about all of the things you have found out about that flower. Challenge: Can you draw a picture and write some facts about this flower?	Design a seed packet In the story the children go to the shops to buy some seeds to plant more flowers. Can you design and make a seed packet for the flower you researched yesterday? Remember to include a title and a picture on the front. Challenge: Can you add some instructions about how and when to plant the seeds?	Design a garden The story is all about a garden. They added lots of different flowers to make it colourful. Can you design your own garden? What would you plant in it? What equipment would we find in your garden? You can use the format in the showbie file or draw your design on a piece of paper. Challenge: Can you write a sentence about your dream garden?






