Welcome

We hope you have all had a wonderful summer, a well-deserved rest and are ready for another busy year. We are really looking forward to getting immersed in our class countries.

It has been wonderful to see all the children return to school with such enthusiasm and confidence to tackle the new year ahead. We have been so impressed with how smart the children have been wearing their uniform – please ensure this is named.

Reading

There will be plenty of reading opportunities during the school day. We will send home a reading book, and hear your child read once a week at school. Please ensure your child has their book bag in school every day as the day they are heard read may vary from week to week. On this site, you are able to find additional books at your child's reading level. We will also read a text as a whole class to develop their comprehension skills.

Phonics

Children will have daily phonics sessions with lots of opportunities for writing. We will be revisiting phases 2-4 whilst progressing onto and working through phase 5.

English We will use a variety of books to link to our writing and the children will be working on securing their understanding of using capital letters and full stops. There will be opportunities for children to develop their oracy skills. English home learning will be given every other week.

Maths

This term in maths we will be developing our mental strategies and instant recall of number facts. We will be using a range of models including tens frames and partwhole models to develop understanding of the relationship between addition and subtraction. We will be revising our knowledge of shapes. Every other week, our home learning will have a practical maths theme, which will develop the skills we have been learning in the classroom.
