- Provide opportunities for children to develop their individual interests
- Acknowledge and celebrate their achievements.
- Prepare your child in their transition to secondary school

## As a parent/ carer:

- Keep up to date and respond to communication from school, ie, consent letters, newsletters and texts as appropriate
- ♦ Encourage your child to ensure they have got everything that they need for the day, ie correct uniform, PE kit, lunch box, water bottle etc.
- Ensure that your child arrives at school safely and on time
- Work in partnership with the school to support the behaviour, E Safety and Safeguarding policies
- ♦ Attend information sessions about your child's education
- Follow school procedures to inform us about your child, ie absence, first aid, changes in collection, personal details
- Support and encourage your child to complete home learning tasks to the best of their ability and to meet their deadlines
- ♦ Help your child to become an independent learner
- Foster a love of learning

## As a learner:

- Follow the school rules and support my peers by acting as positive role models
- Respect the school environment and the people within it
- Wear my uniform with pride
- ♦ Share my learning with my parents/carers
- Go to bed at a time that ensures I am ready for the day ahead
- I will be an Ambassador of Abbots Green both in school and in the community
- Complete my home learning on time and to the best of my ability
- Use IT safely (see acceptable use of ICT policy) for an appropriate length of time
- Find a balance in how I spend my leisure time, e.g. exercise, time online, reading, socialising with friends and family
