
Spring 2024 Evergreen Curriculum News

Polite reminders

Please can all children bring a named fresh water bottle to each nursery session. For hygiene reasons water bottles need to be taken home at the end of each nursery session.

We kindly ask that no toys are brought into nursery. We understand if your child needs a comforter to support settling in.

Unless your child is booked into wrap around care our afternoon session finishes at 3.15pm. We offer a later collection time of 3.25pm for a small cost which can be booked by emailing the office. Please collect your child from nursery before collecting older children from school.

On Monday mornings we have PE with Mr Newson. Please ensure your child has appropriate footwear on so they are able to join in the fun.

Oak Room

This term, Oak room will continue enjoying learning through our key texts each week, with focused story times each day and linked activities. Our key text is displayed in the foyer.

We will continue with our daily Little Wandle phonics sessions and develop our phonological awareness through daily 'Rhyme Time.'

We will be developing our number sense through daily Maths sessions. We will be focusing on accurate counting and number recognition.

In addition, we will be developing our History and Geography knowledge through two key texts 'All the Night Through' and 'The Queen's Hat'.

We will be looking at our focus artists: Piet Mondrian, Vincent Van Gogh, Jackson Pollock and Henri Matisse. We are excited to get started on our own collaborative pieces of art!

Outside Learning

This term, we will enjoy continuing to explore our outside areas in all weathers. As it is getting wetter and colder now please can we ask for children to come to nursery with an appropriate named coat, named hats and gloves to support your child enjoying outside time. Named wellies to keep at nursery help your child to be outside as much as possible.
