Dear Parents and Carers

We continue to be extremely proud of how well children have coped with the strict routines and expectations that have been put into place at Abbots Green. We remain committed to ensuring that we continue to put all government measures into place to keep our staff and children as safe as we possibly can.

Next week, we will continue to offer provision for our Nursery, Reception, and Year 1 children only. Following today's government announcements, we will be reviewing our provision to ensure the very best for our staff and pupils.

As our numbers grow, we do not yet plan to open our Year 6 classes; we do however, feel committed to ensuring that we find a way for our Year 6 pupils to return for a form of transition and reflection of their time at Abbots Green.

From Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June, our provision will continue with the arrangements made this week; it is really important that one parent only brings each child to school at the specified time, to ensure that contact is minimal, and that all parents remain socially distanced from one another. Children will not be let into school site before or after the specified times - this is to ensure that at no point children come into contact with other established bubbles.

We recognise that parents will have mixed feelings about their children returning to school, and that these feelings may change alongside government guidance and announcements.

Attached to this week's update, is the link to our weekly survey. This will enable us to obtain your intention for next week, as well as whether you require a packed lunch provided by the school or whether children will bring their own.

**Please note, that this survey must be completed by all parents who now require a place (that do not have one at present). For those children who have been in school this week, we will assume that this place remains so there is no need for those parents to complete the survey this week - it is our expectation that these parents inform us through class emails if there are any changes.**

To support the school with managing the logistics of establishing bubbles, those children who have attended school this week will remain in their same working bubble, there will be no movement between bubbles.

If your child is not a Nursery, Reception or Year 1, but you feel that you may be eligible for Key Worker provision, please complete the survey attached to inform us of your current needs including days required. This will only be granted for families where **both** parents are physically at a place of work, it is important that this information is shared through the survey.

Please reply by 9am on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June. Whilst the survey remains live, any survey results received after this time will not be allocated a place until the following week.
