Oak Room

This term in Oak room, we are exploring growing flowers outside and how our bodies are growing too. After half term we will be supporting the children in their transitions into Reception. Maple Room

Maple children are making the most of our new outdoor equipment already, especially the climbing wall. To make this safe for everyone please can children have appropriate footwear on, crocs and flipflops are not safe for outside while using the bikes, scooters or when climbing. The children will be exploring how to grow vegetables and flowers outside.

Children who are moving into Oak room in Autumn term will have gentle transitions between the two rooms throughout the second half term. Children will be supported to spend short times in Oak at their own pace. There is an optional Transition drop in on Thursday 5th June between 4.30pm -6pm with Mrs Laing and Mrs Beadle-Hood if you have any questions or concerns with the move into Oak room. Please let us know if you will be attending.

With the warmer weather approaching, please can we remind families of our sun cream policy. Children need to have an all-day sun cream applied before arriving to nursery. We are able to support reapplying sun cream in the afternoon if they are here for tea. Please provide named sun cream if you wish your child to be supported to have it reapplied. Please ensure the consent form previously sent out has been completed. Please can children bring a named sunhat to nursery along with a named water bottle each day.

On Monday mornings we continue PE with Mr Newson. Please ensure your child has appropriate footwear on and are not wearing earrings so they are able to join in the fun.

21st May 10 – 11.15am is Oak room Sports Morning. All children in Oak room are welcome to attend this event with their families for support on the field. Please can children wear trainers to this morning and bring a water bottle and their sunhat.
