We kindly ask that no toys are brought into nursery. Oak room will be encouraged not to bring comforters to nursery this term to support getting ready for school.

Unless your child is booked into wrap around care our afternoon session finishes at 3.15pm. We offer a later collection time of 3.25pm for a small cost which can be booked by emailing the office. Please collect your child from nursery before collecting older children from school.

On Monday mornings we have PE with Mr Newson. Please ensure your child has appropriate footwear on so they are able to join in the fun.



Oak Room

This term Oak room will continue enjoying learning through our key texts each week. Daily phonics and focused story times with linked activities will build on our knowledge and extend our learning. Our key text is displayed in the foyer. Daily Rhyme time will help build our repetoire of nursery rhymes.

During the term we will be looking at our focus Artists in depth – Monet, Warhol, O'Keefe and Seurat. We will be getting creative in how we develop our collaborative art pieces.
