As staff we will:

- Provide children with high quality teaching
- Ensure fairness and safety is at the heart of all that we do
- Work in collaboration with your family, listening and to responding appropriately
- Communicate effectively with you about your child's learning and their behaviours
- Equip your child with the skills needed for the world beyond Abbots Green.
- Support your child to become an active and independent learner.
- Create a safe and nurturing environment.
- Provide children with new and exciting opportunities.

As a parent/ carer:

- Keep up to date and respond to communication from school, ie, consent letters, newsletters and texts as appropriate
- Ensure your child has got everything that they need for the day, ie uniform, PE kit ,lunch box
- Ensure that your child arrives at school safely and on time
- Work in partnership with the school to support the behaviour, E Safety and Safeguarding policies
- Attend information sessions about your child's education
 - Follow school procedures to inform us about your child, ie absence, first aid, changes in collection, personal details
- Support my child with home learning tasks.
- Support your child with their home learning including spelling practice, times table practice and reading which should be recorded at least 3 time each week.
- Discuss your child's school day with them
- Prepare your child for swimming in the summer term.

As a learner

- Follow the school rules and support my peers by acting as positive role model
- Respect the school environment and the people within it
- Wear my uniform with pride
- Share my learning with my parents/ carers
- Go to bed at a time that ensures I am ready for the day ahead
- I will be an Ambassador of Abbots Green both in school and in the community
- Work with my parent/carer to ensure I have everything needed for the school day i.e. water bottle, reading record/ book, PE kit
- Challenge myself each day
- Use IT safely (see acceptable use of ICT policy) for an appropriate length of time
