
Check year 6 out! They have been exploring series circuits in science. They are unstoppable.





We are so proud of our new pack lunch option. A healthy start to the new term.



We know at Abbots Green that our children are all superheroes! Although, some children created capes to show their strengths. We can't wait to see you go from strength to strength. Watch this space!




Year 4
