Starting Nursery for the first time or returning after the long summer break can be a daunting time for some children. We are here to make this experience enjoyable and fun. Through a wide range of activities, the children will soon learn to play together, share resources and make new friends.

We are really excited about our topic this term... 'The Wheels on the Bus'. Through play, the children will be learning about different types of transport and ways of travelling, as well as road safety. We will enjoy learning new songs and listening to stories related to this topic.

As you will have seen, building work for the new nursery is well underway in our outdoor area. The children have been fascinated to see the diggers and cement mixers and we are looking forward to seeing the structure go up. The building work has given us some wonderful opportunities to encourage the children's speaking and listening skills as well as inspiring some fabulous role-play.

Motor Skills

We provide many opportunities for the children to develop their fine motor skills.

Our activities include peg boards, playdough, painting, cutting and collage. We will also use a wide variety of writing tools such as brushes, chalk, sand, shaving foam, glitter and paint rollers to make marks and to begin to form letters.

At snack time we provide milk, water, fresh fruit and toast. Children are also allowed to bring in one healthy snack in a small, named pot.

Please cut grapes in half to avoid choking. Also, please do not bring in any food items containing nuts, including Nutella products.

Please provide your child with a named water bottle which they can access at any time. We kindly ask for a donation of £2 per term to contribute towards the cost of snack and cooking ingredients. Thank You.

We will access the outdoor area every day, therefore please provide your child with a named coat. We also recommend that children have a pair of Wellington boots left on their peg, so that they can enjoy some puddle jumping on wet days.

Maths

Each week, we will choose a child to bring home our Maths Monkey. Each toy monkey has a bag full of maths related activities for you and your child to explore together. Please have fun doing some of them, and return 'Max' or 'Mo-Mo' the following week.



Later on this term, the children will commence their fortnightly visit to the school library. They will be able to choose and bring home a book to share with you. Please spend some time looking at the pictures, reading the story and talking about what is happening.
