This term our topic is 'Into The Woods' we will look at a range of related books such as: Owl Babies, Leaf Man and Pumpkin Soup. The children will have a go at retelling some of the stories, as well as looking at other non-fiction books to broaden their growing vocabularies. We will offer a wide range of mark making opportunities to encourage and support your child's early writing skills. We will continue to explore Phase 1 Phonics, and will support your child in developing a greater understanding of the initial sounds they can hear in both their own names and in CVC (consonant- vowel- consonant) words.
