Literacy	Watch 'Britain in Springtime' BBC Teach on you tube. Talk about the different signs of spring that you saw on the film.	Can you draw a picture of as many different things you can remember that we see in the Spring? When you have drawn your pictures can you label them? Challenge: Can you write one or more sentences to describe Spring. Remember finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.	During the spring many animals give birth to their babies. This includes: ducks – ducklings, sheep – lambs, hens - chicks Watch 'baby chick hatching: egg hatching' on you tube. Challenge: Can you write about the lifecycle of a chicken First, Then, Next, Last.	Read 'That's not my Chick' You may have this book at home if not you can watch it on You Tube. Challenge: Can you write your own story? Choose an animal and use the repeated refrain That's not my it's too	Talk about the Christian Festival 'Easter' that occurs in the season of Spring. What do people do to celebrate? Watch 'Let's Celebrate' Preparing for Easter / Celebrating Easter on You Tube. Challenge: Can you draw an Easter Picture and write one or two sentences about it?
Maths Using a number line	Work with a partner using a number line. Can you find a number one more or one less than a given number? Play Chopper Squad on Top Marks More or Less 1 – 20.	Ask your adult to give you 5 addition number sentences using single digit numbers and work out the answers using your number line. If this is easy then ask for numbers up to 20. Challenge: Write your own addition number sentences and solve them.	Ask your adult to give you 5 subtraction number sentences using single digit numbers and work out the answers using your number line. If this is easy then ask for numbers up to 20. Challenge: Write your own subtraction number sentences and solve them.	On Top Marks spend some time exploring the 'Mental Maths Train Game' addition and subtraction. You can use your number line to help you work out the answers to the questions.	Can you cut up a piece of plain paper into 20 pieces? Then write a number on each piece from 1 – 20. Place each number in the correct sequence starting with 1 (you may need to do this on the floor) then with a partner ask each other 1 more / 1 less questions. E.G What is 1 more than 9?
