Autumn 2025 – Curriculum news

We hope you have all had a wonderful summer, a well-deserved rest and are ready for another year. We are so excited to welcome you all back in September for a brand-new school year full of learning and discovery. This term, we will be diving into some fantastic topics across the curriculum. In Science, we will be exploring Living Things and Their Habitats, and in Geography, we'll learn all about Human and Physical Features. Our History focus will be the Great Fire of London, a fascinating and important subject. Our creativity will shine in Art and Design Technology as we explore drawing and textiles. We can't wait to get started and see all the amazing things we'll achieve together this term!

Reading

Children will have whole class reading sessions throughout the week focusing on a class text. Little Wandle reading groups will take place three times per week. Ready readers will be assigned a reading level to take home the appropriate books. Please listen to your child read at least 3 times a week and record this in your child's reading log.



In English this term we will be focusing on developing our writing skills through a range of topics. We will firstly focus on sentence composition, allowing us to write detailed character descriptions and narratives. We will explore poetry, retelling familiar narratives and writing formal invitations. We will be building confidence in applying our understanding of language to different text types.

⊠⊟ Mathematics

Year 1

Year 1 maths will consist of Place Value within 10, Addition and Subtraction within 10 and Geometry in the Autumn term. Children will develop fluency within these topics by comparing numbers and finding more or less. They will develop strategies to add and subtract using a variety of methods. In Geometry the children will be able to recognise and name both 2D and 3D shapes.

Year 2

Year 2 maths will consist of partitioning numbers using place value. They will develop strategies to add and subtract 2-digit numbers across 10 as well as work out missing numbers from a number sentence. In Geometry they will recognise 2-D and 3-D shapes using mathematical language like vertices and symmetry.
