# Year 1 Summer 2025 – Curriculum News



### April 2025

#### Welcome

We hope you had a relaxing Easter break and are ready for our final term. We begin our term with History finding out about the achievements of 4 different astronauts. In geography, we will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school, its grounds and the key human and physical features. We will use these skills to create our own maps of our community and of the beach when on our trip. This term, in science Year 1 will become experts in plants. We will be learning about the parts of plants, what wild plants are and where we can find them. We will go on a plant hunt around the school grounds and identify the trees and plants we find. In DT, we will be learning how to use a basic running stitch to create our own hand puppets and then 'Why are vegetables the best?' We will also be learning about Judaism in RE. We will be looking at the promises Jews and God make each other, such as the Covenant and the 10 commandments. In PSHE we will be discussing relationships and change.

Year 1 will be writing a setting description of our wonderful school field, as well as studying various forms of poetry. We are looking forward to writing our own instructions in Summer 2, using some bossy imperative verbs!

### Maths



In Maths, we will be learning about equal groups and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will then be finding half and a quarter of shapes and small amounts.

In our number work we will begin to work with numbers to 100. The children will also work with money and begin to tell the time.

There will also be 2 maths meetings per week to revisit prior learning and embed current skills. Please feel free to use Numbots too!
