September 2024

We hope you have all had an excellent summer, a well-deserved rest and are ready for an exciting year ahead! We will begin our term with a history and art focus. In history, we will be exploring how we have grown and changed in our life, whilst in art, we will be learning about making marks using a variety of tools. After this, we will be focusing on DT and geography. In DT we will be discovering how mechanisms work, linking to our English with instructional writing. In geography we will be learning about the seven continents and five oceans of the world. In science, we will be learning all about differences between trees and seasonal changes whilst in computing, we will be focusing on light and dark. PSHE and RE will be taught weekly. In PSHE we will be looking at feelings and celebrating differences. Christianity will be the religion we will focus on in R.E.

Reading

Children will have reading sessions every day, focusing on a class text. Please listen to your child read at least 3 times a week and record this in your child's reading log. In your child's reading log at the front, you will find a bingo book sheet stuck in where you can mark off a book once it has been read. Remember each line marked off wins your child a prize!

English

In the first four weeks we will revisit learning and build upon our knowledge of punctuation and grammar. The children will learn how to write a setting description and create a set of instructions. After half term, the children will learn how to write their own poem and will write a narrative based on a familiar setting.

This term the children in year 2 will explore shape, number and place value and addition and subtraction, working with numbers up to 100. Formal methods, such as tens and ones charts and part whole models, will be used for addition and subtraction throughout.

By the end of Year 2, children are expected to know their 2, 5, 10 and 3 multiplication tables, so any practice of these at home would be greatly appreciated. Times table Rockstar logins will be stuck in your child's reading record.


