


# Bingo board questions Year 4

# Now start reading

## Chapter 1-10

### **VOCABULARY:**

What does the word desolate mean?

What simile is used to describe Aunt sponge? (page 11)

#### **RETRIEVE:**

Did James ever go over the fence? Why?

The size, smell and taste of the peach? The author compares the weight of the growing peach to other things and people. What are they? (most of this information is in chapter 7 and chapter 10)

### **INFER:**

One of the Aunts wanted to eat the peach straight away. Why didn't the other think this would be a good idea?

## Chapter 11-20

## **VOCABULARY:**

Write the definition of the words, scornful and balderdash.

What word did Centipede use to describe how all the animals were feeling? (Pg41), can you think of two other words to describe this feeling?

### **EXPLAIN:**

Why did they need to think of a plan and quickly? How are they going to get the seagulls to fly down?

#### **INFER:**

Why can't they stay in the water? What else could happen to the peach, apart from being eaten, if it stayed in the sea?

## Chapters:20-30

### **VOCABULARY:**

What word is used to describe the audience's reaction? (chapter 24) What does the word vermicious?

#### **RETRIEVE**

What job do earthworms do to help farmers? (Pg. 99)

What does the peach collide with?

Describe the appearance of the cloud men?

### **INFER:**

Write down three things you have learnt about one or more of the creatures in the story.

Do you feel sorry for Centipede when he becomes covered in paint? Why? Why not?
