



Bingo board questions Year 1

<p>RETRIEVE</p>			
<p>What was the little skeleton hiding in on the washing line?</p>			
<p>Look at the pictures, how many windows were there at the front of the Skeletons house?</p>			
<p>INFER</p>			
<p>The Skeletons Have a ride on a skeleton animal they call 'Nellie', what type of animal is it meant to be?</p>			
<p>Why do the skeletons only come out at night?</p>			
<p>PREDICT</p>			
<p>Why do you think they decided to keep out of the crocodile's way?</p>			
<p>Where do you think the skeletons might find someone to frighten in the middle of the night? Who works at night time?</p>
