
If your child has anything related to our topic that they would like to bring in, we would love to see it.

English One of our main aims this year is for the children to gain confidence in writing independently for a range of reasons. Please encourage this at home and if the children would like to, they can bring in writing from home for our WOW wall.

Phonics is a big focus this year and is incorporated into the children's reading and writing. We will be using a range of toy themed fiction and non-fiction texts as a starting point for their writing. The children will be encouraged to go through stages when writing; firstly saying their sentence out loud, then writing it using their phonic knowledge and finally re-reading what they have written.

Mathematics In Maths, we will be linking lots of our activities to our toys theme. Throughout all sessions we will work on number formation, especially the 'teens' numbers. The children will be practising counting accurately in ones and tens. We will also be representing numbers in different ways and comparing them. The children will be challenged to add & subtract small numbers as well as read and create number sentences using + - =.
