## English

Children will be exploring different genres within our topic, to include retrieving information from non-fiction texts to write a detailed report about London, writing a traditional tale of a wolf blowing down famous landmarks and a detailed newspaper report on Guy Fawkes.

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Children will explore number and place value this term, working with numbers with up to 100. We will use concrete resources to help their understanding before moving onto problem solving activities to further their understanding of the number system. Formal methods, such as the empty number line, will be used for addition and subtraction. In Year 2, children are expected to know their 2's, 5's, 10's and 3 times table, so any practise of these at home would be greatly appreciated.
